During this season of thanksgiving and prayer, I humbly thank you for your support, patience, and warm welcome as I returned to the role of Principal of St. Paul School; it felt like coming home again after a long time away. St. Paul School is such a unique and special school. I had forgotten what a gift it is to witness the miracle of Christmas through the eyes of these young students. St. Paul School has accomplished so much in these few short months. We have made great strides in increasing our security and safety at our school. Most recently, we received funding from the Serra Foundation to make our glass doors shatterproof. This fall, we installed a new alarm system complete with panic buttons and motion sensors. With the help of a very generous and talented school family, we installed a new fence around the back of the school for added safety. The school purchased a new reading curriculum for grades K-6, a new PK 3 curriculum, and a supplemental math and reading program to help increase our test scores. Our next step is to update our science, math, and history curriculum as well as purchase additional cameras to replace the ones that are becoming obsolete.

As we enter the new year, St. Paul School is excited about our future. We invite you to consider becoming a part of our growth and progress. Our Annual Fund campaign is an effort to secure gifts to support and complete projects that would otherwise not be possible. The Annual Fund also assists us in keeping tuition at an affordable rate. Our actual cost to educate each student is roughly, \$8,000.00, while our tuition cost is \$4,135.00. The success of our fundraisers and Annual Fund help to defray this deficit.
